  - II. **18/02072/TCA** Patrington Conservation Area. S1 Magnolia: fell, T1 Larch: dead wood. T2 Cypress; fell, T3 Cypress; fell – both outgrown location. T4 Sycamore; remove x2 low branches over wall as 2.5m on stem. T5 Cherry; remove one limb on eastern side of tree which extends towards building at 2.5m and overall crown reduction by 20% to retain crown shape, T6 Yew; remove one low branch on eastern side of tree at 1m above ground and deadwood, T7 Ash: fell, T8 Sycamore; fell as too close to church wall, T9 Cypress; fell as out grown location, T11 Cypress; fell as outgrown location – to provide light too garden and building.
