## **Minutes of the Extraordinary Council Meeting of Patrington Parish Council**

The chair informed the meeting that once a verbal report had been received from the steering group he would ask each councillor to give their views on the market.

Cllr M Tyler gave a short report about the meeting and had produced a summary of the results of the survey that had been circulated with the agenda.

Cllr J Gent gave a short verbal report including the reply from the PPCC (Patrington Parochial Church Council), the reply stated that under the terms of the lease, we are unable to hold a market on the carpark and the Parish Council would have to negotiate a new lease and upgrade the carpark. In addition, the carpark needs to be available for full use when there is a funeral or wedding. Due to this, the Church carpark is no longer an option for a venue for the Market.

Each councillor gave their opinions and below are some of the comments:

- Enhance the village and bring in new visitors and customers for the existing businesses.
- Only have stalls that do not conflict with shops in the market place.
- Hold the market when other events are taking place in the village.
- Concerns regarding parking, where will the extra cars, vans park. Effect on residents of the Market place noise no parking after 8.00am.
- The results of the Facebook survey show that people would like to see a market.

The meeting discussed the pros and cons of a market and unanimously agreed the following:

The Clerk will apply for the closure of the parking bays on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> May, 8<sup>th</sup> June and 13<sup>th</sup> July from 8.00 am until 3 pm in accordance with ERYC guidelines. Cllr Gent and Tyler are to speak to market traders to find out if they would like to have a stall with a maximum of 8 stalls. The clerk asked them that all stall holders need liability insurance. There will be no charge for the stalls if they commit to the 3 dates. After each market is held, the Council will consider if the next market will take place. If the application for the closure of the bays is unsuccessful the Parish Council will discuss different locations.

**The Chairman thanked everyone for attending and closed the meeting at 8.08 pm.**
