20) **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING HELD ON 8th APRIL 2019:**

21) **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE ABOVE MEETING:**

- a) **St Patricks Churchyard- update;** Phase two of the wall on Church lane is complete and a quotation to complete phase three was presented to the meeting. The meeting unanimously agreed that JD Services complete phase three. The kissing gates need refurbishing and the meeting unanimously agreed that the Clerk ask Red Hall for a quotation for the cost of sandblasting and repainting the two kissing gates. The meeting discussed the eastern boundary and unanimously agreed a new hedge would be nicer visually then a wooden fence. The Clerk is to speak to Stuart Smith about planting and clearing the boundary.
- b) **Patrington Market ;** The village hall is unavailable on a Saturday morning due to a new weekly booking.
- c) **Flag update;** The Clerk gave a verbal report and the meeting unanimously agreed that 10 flags are purchased. The meeting discussed presenting one flag to the school as part of the 50 years celebrations and the student whose idea helped with the main part of the design will receive a gift from the Parish Council.

- a) The Council considered the below application and unanimously agreed the following decisions:-
- I. **19/01161/PLF** Erection of detached dwelling. Land north of Sirron House 22 Greenshaw Lane Patrington. HU12 0RL. Mrs E Stephenson. Full Planning Permission. **SUPPORT**
 - II. **19/01165/PLF** Erection of two-storey extension to rear with dormer windows and Juliet balcony, alterations to increase roof height with installation of dormer windows to front and erection of box window to side. The Cottage Winestead Grange Farm Bydales Winestead HU12 0NN. Mr W Holt. Full Planning Permission. **SUPPORT**
 - III. **19/00786/STPLFE** Manage realignment at Welwick to Skeffling comprising new earth embankments habitat creation and mitigation area with associated works including new carpark, viewing platforms or bird hides, fencing, footpaths and footbridge improvement, gravity fall drain and ramp over new flood embankment to enable machinery access. Land West and South West of Long Lane Skeffling HU12 0UX. The Environment Agency and ABP. Strategic with full planning with EIA. **The meeting unanimously agreed that the Clerk contact ERYC and ask for an extension and arrange a meeting with South Holderness drainage board and will make a decision at the next meeting.**
 - IV. **19/00783/STPLFE** Outstrays Managed Realignment Scheme comprising new earth embankments, habitat creation and mitigation area with associated works including pilling, new viewing platforms or bird hide, reinstatement of bird hive at Haverfield Quarry, creation of new passive access from Outstrays Farm to western end of West 1, creation of public access route around the edge of West 2, improvement of other footpaths and bridges, access ramps, provision of fencing, French drain and vegetation clearance including woodland at western end of West 1. Land South west of Welwick Bank Bridge Humber Side Lane Welwick HU12 0QT. The Environment Agency. Strategic Full Planning with EIA. **The meeting unanimously agreed that the Clerk contact ERYC and ask for an extension and arrange a meeting with South Holderness drainage board and will make a decision at the next meeting.**
