60) **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MONTHLY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 15th JULY 2019:**

61) **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE ABOVE MEETING:**

- a) **St Patricks Churchyard- update;** Work on the kissing gate wall has started.
- b) **Cemetery gates – update;** Awaiting quotations. The next row of burial plots has a bench over the area. The meeting agreed the bench should be moved further up the path. The Clerk is to consider locations.
- c) **Flag update;** The flag is now flying and the Chair presented a flag to Patrington Haven Leisure Park. The meeting asked Cllr Gent to pass thanks to her son Dan Gent for filming the event with a drone and producing a short film, which can be seen on the Patrington Facebook page as it is too large for the Parish Council website.
- d) **CCTV;** Cllr R Snaith gave a verbal report about locations and costings. Cllr Gent told the meeting that Hedon Town Council had received a grant for their recent update of CCTV equipment. The Clerk is to find out about the grant and report to the September meeting.
- e) **Christmas Lights;** The meeting confirmed the lights switch on is Sunday 8th December. R Aklam can attend and the majority of the businesses are happy with the date change. The Clerk is to follow up with the Christmas tree supplier about location and costings.
