68) **ERYC UPDATE FROM WARD COUNCILLOR;** Cllr P Whitehead gave a short verbal report –

- Ongoing work regarding problems with doctor's surgery and Patrington post office.
- Flashing speed limit sign near playing field is not working correctly, it has been reported to ERYC who have said they do not have funds to repair it. The Clerk is to send the information to Cllr Whitehead who will follow this up.

72) **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MONTHLY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 12<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2019:**

The minutes of the meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> August 2019 after being duly circulated were adopted as a true record. Proposed Cllr A Tuniewicz, seconded Cllr D Snaith. Unanimously agreed.

73) **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE ABOVE MEETING:**

- a) **St Patricks Churchyard- update;** Works on the kissing gates and wall are completed and photos are on the website.
- b) **Cemetery gates – update;** Awaiting quotations.
- c) **CCTV;** The Clerk gave a verbal report regarding the grant available from East Riding Crime Reduction Fund and the meeting unanimously agreed that the Clerk should continue with the grant process and ask for a quotation from Visual Security and Palmer Electrical.
- d) **Christmas Lights;** The Clerk gave a verbal report about the purchasing of permanent Christmas Tree. After discussion with a supplier, concerns were raised that a tree will not survive in the location. The meeting discussed that the main Christmas tree should still be moved near the toilets and the current large planter be replaced with a purpose built planter to allow the Christmas tree to be placed inside every year.
- e) **RP Waller £1000 legacy;** The meeting discussed the use of the legacy and unanimously agreed that the money should be used to paint the toilets and replace the mens sink. The Clerk is to ask for a quotation from Mr Hairsine who has previously painted the toilets.
- f) **Community Speed Check;** The Clerk gave a verbal report and the meeting unanimously agreed that Patrington Haven Road, High Street, Market Place, Westgate and Southside should be considered for locations and Cllr P Wilson, T Bearpark, J Gent, J Edmunds and J Kitchener will be volunteers who will be trained. The Clerk will proceed with the process and request speed surveys from ERYC for these locations.
- g) **Representative on ERYC Standards Committee;** No Councillor wanted to be a representative.

- I. **19/01511/PLF** Erection of marquee building with timber decking for use as an event venue (retrospective application) The White Hall Estate Marquee Patrington Road Winestead HU12 0NJ. BluTrust. Full Planning Permission.  
*The meeting unanimously agreed that a decision would be made once the ERYC Public Protection comments and Licencing comments are received. The Clerk will inform the case officer.*
  - II. **19/02877/TCA** Patrington Conservation Area; Dismantle Blue Cedar in front garden. Tree has been planted on a raised bed and is pushing out the wall to the entrance wat. The tree has also been planted underneath mature trees so it has grown at a worrying angle to find light. Blue Cedar Cottage 7 Station road Patrington HU12 0NE. Mr H Naylor. Tree Works in conversation area. No objection.
  - III. **19/02923/PLF Erection** of two-storey extension to side, following partial demolition of existing single storey extension. 2 New Cottages Bydales Lane Winestead HU12 0NW. Mr J McCloud. Full Planning Permission. **SUPPORT**

Application considered by Eastern Area Planning Sub Committee on 2/9/19 and a site visit was requested and to be considered at the next planning committee meeting on 23/9/19.
