108) ERYC UPDATE FROM WARD COUNCILLOR;

Cllr Tucker gave a verbal report regarding the work the South East Holderness Councillors have conducted over the last few months including update on the flooding and ERYC working with Internal Drainage Board. A street surgery was held in Patrington on Saturday 9th November and was a success. Footpaths along Humber Lane and Westgate will have a slurry seal and Cllr Tucker is arranging for a visit to Westfield after concerns have been raised about insufficient parking. 112) MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MONTHLY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 14TH OCTOBER 2019:

The minutes of the meeting held on 14th October 2019 after being duly circulated were adopted as a true record. Proposed Cllr J Kitchener seconded Cllr R Snaith. Unanimously agreed.

113) MATTERS ARISING FROM THE ABOVE MEETING:

- a) **CCTV;** The Clerk gave a verbal report regarding the CCTV and grant application, the application has been submitted. A further quotation is needed the Clerk will arrange for this.
- b) **Christmas Lights;** The Clerk gave a verbal about the upcoming event on Sunday 8th December. Road closure is taking place from 2.30pm and help is needed for the road closure at least 4 Cllr's are needed. The lights will be going up over the next 2 weekends. A base for the tree has been made and needs fitting which will hopefully be done by the event or the tree will be in the old place. Patrington Fire Brigade will pay for the selection boxes and the meeting unanimously agreed that the Clerk can arrange to hire a Grotto if the costs do not exceed £200. The Clerk has tried to get KCFM but unfortunately has been unable to confirm them however there may be a charge if they can come but unsure what it will be.
- c) **Local Shops sign on toilets;** The Clerk gave a verbal report regarding planning implications of a sign been placed on the toilets and that the rules are extremely complicated. A brown ERYC sign will cost £175 for the initial enquiry and the Council have been previously told that no more signs can be added onto the area near the war memorial. The meeting agreed to discuss this further at a future meeting.
- d) **Millennium Oak;** The Clerk gave a verbal report, the original oak that was planted maybe dead or dormant from shock but Mr Garbutt has a small whip that has been grown from the original oak which he will plant and if the original oak starts growing again he will remove the whip. The meeting unanimously agreed that the Clerk thank Mr Garbutt for his work and ask him to plant the sapling. Discuss further in the spring.
