- b) **Toilets update:** The sinks have been purchased and will be fitted shortly. The toilets did not have to close as the Cleaning Fairies from Withernsea cleaned the toilets for 14 days and charged £210 and they did an excellent job. Toilets to continue to be fogged and opened 10am to 4.00pm.
- c) **Telephone Box:** The Clerk has informed ERYC that the Parish Council will purchase the telephone box the meeting agreed that until the purchase is complete no decision would be made on its use.
- d) **Patrington Haven Land;** The meeting unanimously agreed that the Land should not be sold as the land is the only land available at Patrington Haven owned by the Parish Council and everyone should be allowed to use it.
- e) **Textile bank at playing field and purchase of bins;** The Clerk is awaiting further information and a decision will be made once this information is received. The round bin near the bin will be moved to near the hut.
