43) **ERYC UPDATE FROM WARD COUNCILLOR;** Cllr Holmes has attended public sessions with Keyingham and Ottringham Parish Council with a focus on improving road safety through the villages. Patrington Parish Council's request for improved crossing facilities on the main road within the village has been placed on the speed management forward programme of work, to await resource. Any decision will be dependent on a budget being available and the results of traffic surveys.

48) **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING HELD ON 13th JUNE 2022:**

49) **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE ABOVE MEETING:**

a) **Christmas Lights and Scarecrow Trail** – The Clerk gave a verbal report and the meeting discussed the date of the Light Switch On. It was agreed that the date would be Sunday 27th November to co-inside with St Patricks Church Christmas Market. The Clerk is to contact Father Christmas and others to confirm they will attend.

The Clerk gave a verbal report to the meeting re the scarecrow trail, the Parish Council does not run this and last year Rich Snaith and Diane Chapman arranged the trail. Over 400 people viewed a request on Facebook for volunteers to help but no one came forward. If this goes ahead, again this year help is needed. The date agreed was September 3rd and 4th the same weekend as the Church Flower festival. Cllr Holmes would like to organise a produce show like Roos Show for the same weekend and will produce a poster to be sent out to all households in Patrington asking for help with both. Cllr Tuniewicz will print the posters.

 - I. **22/01972/PLF and 22/01973/PLB** Internal works including relocation of staircase and installation of a stud partition wall following the change of use of part of a dwelling to holiday accommodation, replacement of existing gate with steel framed gate to front, section of dilapidated wall to be dismantled and rebuilt with reclaimed materials at front, replacement of existing timber doors and frames to front and rear, construction of new window to rear and replacement of timber window at side with obscure glass., Wyke House 36 Greenshaw Lane Patrington Mr and Mrs Rothery Full Planning Permission and Listed Building Consent. **SUPPORT**
 - II. **22/02061/TCA** WINESTEAD CONSERVATION AREA – Fell 2no mature Ash Trees (G1) growing together riddled with Ivy, trees have clear signs of Ash dies back and are growing close to house and mains power lines. G1 also Fell 1no Pine tree (T1) as outgrown its position and causing excessive shade against house. Brookwood Winestead Lane Winestead HU12 0NN Mrs V Smith Tree works in Conservation area. **NO OBJECTIONS**
 - III. **22/02005/PAD** Display of vinyl wrapping image 1no roller shutter to front elevation (Retrospective Application) Patrington Fire Station Northside Patrington Humberside Fire and Rescue Services. Consent to Display and Advertisement. **SUPPORT**
