**Minutes of the Council Meeting of Patrington Parish Council
Held in Patrington Village Hall on 8th August 2022 at 7.15 pm**

56) **ERYC UPDATE FROM WARD COUNCILLOR;** No ward councillor present.

57) **PARISHIONERS QUESTIONS:** Ward Councillor Brian Skow (Mid Holderness) gave Cllr Tuniewicz a document, outside the meeting, to be read out at the meeting regarding planning application 22/02187/PLF. The Vice-Chair read out the document which had items to discuss and which highlighted comments that had already being submitted to ERYC and the comments are on public access by other consultees. The Parish Council have not kept the document, as Ward Councillor Skow wanted the document returning.

60) **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING HELD ON 13th JULY 2022:**

The minutes of the meeting held on 13th July 2022 after being duly circulated were adopted as a true record. Proposed Cllr J Kitchener and seconded Cllr D Snaith. Unanimously agreed.

61) **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE ABOVE MEETING:**

a) **Christmas Lights and Scarecrow Trail** – The Clerk gave a verbal report re the Christmas Lights Switch on.

The Clerk has asked Kevin Young to play and Father Christmas is coming. The Fire Engine will attend and the Clerk is liaising with East Riding Band about playing at the event. The Clerk has liaised with PJD and they provide an estimate of the work needed to update the lights around the village for the September meeting.

The Clerk and Cllr R Snaith had prepared a document as suggested by Cllr Holmes of what needed doing to organise the Scarecrow event and how long and how many people are needed. This was circulated to the meeting. As previously stated the Scarecrow event was not organised by the Parish Council but the Clerk (Diane Chapman) had helped Cllr R Snaith last year to run the event and it had always being a Patrington AFC event.

Cllr R Snaith said one person had commented on the Facebook post today saying we would help (which had had over 400 views since it had being posted in June). The meeting discussed if the Parish Council would be able to run the event, the meeting unanimously agreed that they would not be able to take over the running of event this year but would support anyone if they wanted to arrange the scarecrow event this year.

Diane Chapman and Richard Snaith as the 2 organisers of the event last year decided that they would not be able to organise the event this year and will post on the Scarecrow Trail Facebook page that the event will not go ahead.

- b) **Newsletter**- Cllr Bearpark gave a verbal report – the newsletter had been download over 120 times and well received. Another newsletter will be produced for the end of September.
- c) **CCTV at playing field**- Cllr R Snaith gave a verbal report regarding the CCTV and has being approached by a sponsor of a Patrington AFC team that may provide the equipment. Patrington Playing field association will discuss the use of CCTV further.

- a) The Council considered the below application and agreed the following decisions:-

Cllr Holmes abstained from voting on planning applications, as she is a Ward Councillor and portfolio holder for planning, infrastructure and housing.

- I. **22/ 03048/PLF Change of use of land for sitting of 8 lodges (holiday lets) with amenities following demolition of redundant stables.** Livery Stables The White Hall Patrington Road Winestead HU12 0NJ Blustrust **FULL PLANNING PERMISSION. Unanimously agreed to SUPPORT the *application* subject to the conservation officer's comments that the lodges do not affect the view of the Hall and more information is received from the applicant.**
- II. **22/02187/PLF Erection of 9 swellings with associated access, garages, parking and infrastructure.** Land east of Guardians Road Patrington HU12 0NY Pentile Construction. **FULL PLANNING PERMISSION. Majority voted to SUPPORT the application 9 for 2 against.**
To support the application and noted the comments made from the public. The Parish Council would like to see a mix of 2/3/4 bedroom houses on the site. Could a planning condition be added to the permission stating that a percentage of the houses are for 1st buyers or local people and no buy to let buyers
