51) **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE ABOVE MEETING:**

- a) **Christmas Lights and Switch ON** – The event will take place on Sunday 1st December. Withernsea ladies choir will sing but need better lights and microphones. Yorkshire Air ambulance will attend and Patrington Fire Brigade. Cllr Murphy will ask Mrs Lazenby to attend with a food truck and Mike the DJ if he can provide sound system and more mics.
- b) **Hanging Baskets** – Thank you to Cllr Tuniewicz and Mr A Goundrill. The Clerk has planted the planters on Westgate.
- c) **School Road Safety update and 20mph zone** – The Chair gave a verbal report and we have received no further information from the school. The Chair will contact Mrs Pepper in September when the new school term starts. ERYC are extending the mandatory School Keep Clear markings to cover the pedestrian access.
The meeting discussed the invitation from ERYC for Town and Parish Councils to propose sites for 20 mph zones. The Clerk confirmed that the Parish Council would have to meet additional costs over £20k. The meeting considered this and agreed that Southside from Welwick road to the 40mph speed limit signs on Patrington Haven Road be considered.
- d) **Station Road Bench** – Mr Rix who's caravan damage the bench and planter has agreed to cover the costs. The wood is still usable but the cast iron has broken. Cllr Tuniewicz proposed that there is a bench at the cemetery that is the same but the wood is in need of repair and we could move this bench to Station Road and replace the wood with the destroyed bench wood. The Clerk is to speak to Mr S Smith and ask if he will be able to complete the work. The Clerk will purchase a new planter.
