Patrington Parish Council Volunteer Awards Policy

1. Introduction

- 1.1 Patrington parish Council (PPC) recognises the dedication and commitment of local people in supporting the aims of the Parish Council.
- 1.2 The Parish Council will make available a Volunteer Award scheme to recognise the outstanding contribution of individuals to the local community over the age of 18.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 To be eligible to be nominated for a Volunteer Award and individual must either be a resident of, or work within Patrington, Patrington Haven or Winestead.
- 2.2 Nominations may only be made by residents of, or those that work within, the Patrington Parish.
- 2.3 Parish Councillors may make nominations but will then be excluded from the decision-making process or any involvement therein.
- 2.4 Existing Councillors are ineligible for nomination.

3. Nominations

- 3.1 Residents will be invited to nominate an individual(s)/community group who they feel has made a significant contribution to the local community, either through a specific action or as a cumulative effect over a longer period of time.
- 3.2 Nominations will be made via the application form which can be collected from local businesses or downloaded via the website/social media.
- 3.3 The nomination period will be advertised on the Parish Council website, via the Parish Council Facebook feeds, willing retail/social outlets and in Parish Council noticeboards.
- 3.4 The nomination period each year will begin on 1st October and will close on 31st October will be managed by the Parish Clerk.

4. Decision making

- 4.1 Nominations will be reviewed by the Council at its meeting in November and winner(s) decided.
- 4.2 The Council may decide to appoint a committee/working group to review the nominations in the event of a significant number being received.
- 4.3 The winner(s) will be notified and invited to attend the December parish meeting, where the presentation will be made by the Chair.
- 4.4 Everyone who is nominated will receive a letter thanking them and congratulating them for all they do for the Parish.
- 4.5 PPC reserves the right to make more than one award each year, or to make no award if there are no suitable nominations.
